Project background

Waukesha County is planning a federally-funded Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) project along CTH C at Hasslinger Drive in the Village of Chenequa. The proposed project is to correct causes of collisions and address other safety problems along the northbound and southbound directions of this curved segment of CTH C. Improvements being considered at this location include realignment of the curve on CTH C, combining Hasslinger Drive, the private driveway, and the private road (Oakland Road) as one common intersection and adjusting the CTH C profile along this highway curve for improved intersection area visibility.

Public Information Meeting agenda

This is the second meeting being held on this project. The project was initially introduced at a Public Meeting on June 26, 2019. Based on input and comments from that meeting, the County has refined the design elements and is presenting the refined designs to the public at this event.

The meeting will be conducted in an open house format with no formal presentation. The public is encouraged to stop by anytime between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. Representatives from Waukesha County will be available to discuss the project, answer questions, and gather input and comments from the public. Maps and other exhibits will be on display for viewing.

The meeting site is ADA accessible. Hearing-impaired citizens may request an interpreter by contacting our office at least three working days prior to the meeting via the Wisconsin Telecommunications Relay system (1-800-WI-RELAY).
